## Where Do We Go From Here?:

### SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 99

WHEREAS, a broad-based task force is needed to make concrete policy recommendations to the legislature in order to address the issue of public access on the navigable waters of the state.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby create the Public Recreation Access Task Force to study the conditions, needs, and issues relative to potential public recreation access on the navigable waters of the state and to make recommendations to the legislature

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall make recommendations to the legislature no later than February 1, 2020, at which time the task force shall cease to exist, although the task force may disband at an earlier date following a two-thirds vote of the membership.
