The inclinometers to be installed in the swamp will be accessed via airboat. Posts will be set in the ground and the meters mounted to these posts for stability. Solar panels will be installed on these posts to provide power. Data will be sent wirelessly by the meters to a data collection machine at the central command office.</p>

PPE will include hearing protection, non-steel toed boots (boating safety), life vests, and safety glasses.</p>






