Dear Oversight Authorities:

The Commissioner of Conservation proposes to amend LAC 43:XIX.118 in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act R.S. 49:950 et seq., and pursuant to the power delegated under the laws of the state of Louisiana. The proposed amendment is made to extend the time frame for submitting the Work History Report following a hydraulic fracture stimulation operation from 20 days to 30 days.

II. Statement of the proposed action per La R.S. 49:968.C(2):

The Louisiana Office of Conservation proposes to amend LAC 43:XIX.118 in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act, R.S. 49:950 et seq., and pursuant to the power delegated under the laws of the State of Louisiana. The proposed amendment is made to extend the time frame for submitting the Work History Report following a hydraulic fracture stimulation operation from 20 days to 30 days.

IV. Statement of the circumstances requiring amendment of the rule per La R.S. 49:968.C(4):

The proposed amendment is made at the request of the regulated industry. As a result of better technology allowing for longer laterals, the time necessary to prepare the surveys required to be filed with the Work History Report has increased. Conservation recognizes this as a legitimate request.


V. Statement of the fiscal and economic impact of the proposed rule amendment per La R.S. 49:968.C(5):
