Re: Renewal of Louisiana Water Well Contractor's (Driller's) License

Your current Louisiana Water Well Contractor's (Driller's) License will expire on June 30, 2022. To apply for renewal of your license, please read the enclosed instruction sheet and complete the attached license renewal application form, the Continuing Education Certificate Form, enclose your annual renewal fee check or money order issued only to the order of the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development (LDOTD) - and return all items to the Louisiana Department of Natural Resources (LDNR) - Environmental Division using the P.O. Box address at the bottom of the included Instructions page. Your annual renewal fee is \$100.00, unless you drill only domestic water wells (as defined in Appendix I of the Water Well Rules, Regulations and Standards) and you drill less than 25 domestic wells annually, in which case the renewal fee is \$50.00. Please note that the drilling record portion of the form **must** be completed.

If you **do not intend to renew your license**, please check the response below and return this letter to LDNR – Environmental Division using the P.O. Box address at the bottom of this page.
