Comprising nearly one million acres, the Atchafalaya Basin is one of the crown jewels of Louisiana. The Atchafalaya Basin stretches for 140 miles from Simmesport to Morgan City and is our nation's largest and most productive river swamp. The Louisiana Department of Natural Resources is entrusted, through the Atchafalaya Basin Program, to conserve, restore, and enhance this natural treasure for generations to come.

The Atchafalaya Basin Geotrail was developed to showcase how the region's history, culture, and ecology has been and continues to be defined by water.

What is it?

Geocaching is a real-world, outdoor treasure hunting game that uses GPS-enabled devices.

Participants navigate to a specific set of GPS coordinates and then attempt to find the geocache (container) hidden at that location. See [Geocaching 101](#) for all the information you need. to get started!
