RE: Coastal Management Plan update for Calcasieu Parish Local Coastal Zone Management Program


Dear Mr. Lovell:

Enclosed please find a resolution from the Calcasieu Parish Police Jury adopting the updates to the Coastal Management Plan. The revisions include changes to the maps and extending of the environmental management units from the formally adopted plan dated October 16, 1986. This update was necessary due to the 2012 coastal boundary change which increased the Calcasieu Coastal Zone by 102 square miles. The Parish has provided your office with the Coastal Management Plan update.

The Parish is requesting consideration and approval for this Coastal Management Plan update from the State of Louisiana Department of Natural Resources and the National Atmospheric and Oceanographic Administration.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, coastal zone management is needed in the Calcasieu-Sabine Basin; and

WHEREAS, the original Coastal Zone Boundary was established by state law in 1978, amended by the Louisiana Legislature in 1979, 1980 and 2012, and Act 588 of the 2012 Louisiana Legislature modified the coastal zone's inland boundary in accordance with a science-based study; and

WHEREAS, results of the 2012 boundary change added a net of 1,887 square miles to the Louisiana coastal zone which was an increase of about 12.6%, and the Calcasieu Parish Coastal Zone increased by 102 square miles as a result thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Coastal Management Plan for Calcasieu Parish was adopted on October 16, 1986, with an update to the Coastal Management Plan completed in March of 2017, which included revisions to the maps and extended the environmental management units necessary because of the coastal zone change of 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE,


