- LOCATION:** Lafourche, Terrebonne Parishes, LA; Lat. 29° 25' 05.26"N, Long. 90° 26' 55.06"W;
Sections 17 & 20, T19S-R20E; Pointe-Aux-Chenes, LA
- DESCRIPTION:** Proposed construction of approx. 1,104' of the first lift of the Bayou Pointe Aux Chenes levee system. Approx. 15,545 cu. yds. of hauled-in material and approx. 111 cu. yds. of crushed stone will be required for levee construction. No excavation or other fill will be required. Approximately 5.0 acres of wetlands and/or non-vegetated waterbottoms may be impacted by the proposed project.
- REVISION 1:** Proposed installation of a 24" diameter x 240' long Prestressed Concrete Cylinder Pressure Pipe (PCCP) and Sluice Gate Assembly beneath the levee on the Terrebonne Parish side of Bayou Pointe - Aux - Chenes, west of LA HWY 665. The sluice gate assembly shall be constructed on the protected side of the First Lift Levee System. The sluice gate assembly shall remain in an open position at all times to provide drainage flow from the areas south of the proposed levee. When high water conditions are anticipated, the sluice gate shall be closed. POB of 24" culvert and location of sluice gate: Lat. 29 25' 04.84"/Long. 90 26' 58.61"; POE of 24" culvert: Lat. 29 25' 02.50"/Long. 90 26' 58.36".
- REVISION 2:** Request to extend the permit term.
- REVISION 3:** Proposed installation and realignment of a barge gate in-lieu of a sector gate. An additional 21,100 cy. of native material will be displaced during dredging activities and an additional 5,500 cy. of rip-rap will be required for bank stabilization.

NOTICE the Louisiana Department of Natural Resources, Office of Coastal Management (OCM) has received the above application for a Coastal Use Permit (CUP) in accordance with the State and Local Coastal Resources Management Act of 1978, as amended, (Louisiana R.S. 49:214.21-214.41), and the rules and regulations of the Coastal Resources Program. Written comments, including suggestions for modifications or objections to the proposed work and stating the reasons thereof, are being solicited from the public. Comments must be received within 25 days of the date of publication of this notice. Comments should be uploaded to our

electronic record, but may be mailed, faxed or emailed to the designated OCM Reviewer. All comments must contain the appropriate application number and the commenter's full name and contact information.

The public comment period for Coastal Use Permit applications begins on the date of publication of notice in the official journal (The Advocate), in accordance with LAC 43:I. 723(C)(5)(c). OCM will provide this date on request.

Any person may request, in writing, within the comment period specified in this notice, that a State or Federal public hearing be held to consider this application. Requests for public hearings shall state, with particularity, the reasons for holding a public hearing and must contain the name and contact information of the requester.
