**DESCRIPTION:** Proposed construction and planting of approximately 4,000-feet of terraces for the purpose of compensatory mitigation for impacts to intermediate marsh from the construction of the Little Chenier Water Relief permitted under CUP # P20090644/P20140265. The mitigation Project will include the dredging of approximately 21,425 cubic yards from adjacent waterbottoms to construct four (4) terraces. Each terrace shall measure approximately 960' x 38' and have a top width of 10'. Each terrace shall have a settled elevation of +2.5' NAVD 88 and shall be planted with *Spartina alterniflora* plugs in rows on 2-foot centers.

**REVISION 1:** Extension (2 years) of previously authorized project initiation and completion. NOTICE the Louisiana Department of Natural Resources, Office of Coastal Management (OCM) has received a request to extend both the two year period for initiation of work and the permit period for the above referenced Coastal Use Permit in accordance with the State and Local Coastal Resources Management Act of 1978, as amended, (Louisiana R.S. 49:214.21-214.41), and the rules and regulations of the Coastal Resources Program. Copies may be obtained upon payment of cost of copying. The sole reason for not allowing extension based upon public comment shall be that there has been a change in the conditions of the area affected by the permit since the permit was originally issued. Comments should be uploaded to our electronic record, but may be mailed, faxed or emailed to the designated OCM Reviewer. All comments must contain the appropriate application number and the commenter's full name and contact information.
