DESCRIPTION: Proposed removal of OA A0276 Well No. 1, one 7' x 9' well protector platform, ten 3-pile clusters, (22) single pilings and abandon-in-place and/or removal of two existing 4" pipelines (920' and 708'). Approximately 1,528 cubic yards of material may be displaced by jetting for pipeline removal. No dredging for access is required. Draft of work vessels will be 4.5'.

REVISION 1: This is an extension.

NOTICE the Louisiana Department of Natural Resources, Office of Coastal Management (OCM) has received a request to extend the two year period for initiation of work for the above referenced Coastal Use Permit in accordance with the State and Local Coastal Resources Management Act of 1978, as amended, (Louisiana R.S. 49:214.21-214.41), and the rules and regulations of the Coastal Resources Program. Written comments, including suggestions for modifications or objections to the proposed work and stating the reasons thereof, are being solicited from the public. Comments must be received within 10 days of the date of publication of this notice. The sole reason for not allowing extension based upon public comment shall be that there has been a change in the conditions of the area affected by the permit since the permit was originally issued. Comments should be uploaded to our electronic record, but may be mailed, faxed or emailed to the designated OCM Reviewer. All comments must contain the appropriate application number and the commenter's full name and contact information.
