LOCATION: In the Louisiana Coastal Parishes of Ascension, Assumption, Calcasieu, Cameron, Iberia, Jefferson, Lafourche, Livingston, Orleans, Plaquemines, St. Bernard, St. Charles, St. James, St. John the Baptist, St. Martin, St. Mary, St. Tammany, Tangipahoa, Terrebonne and Vermilion.

DESCRIPTION: This General Permit provides for operations for seismic surveys to include surveying locations, placement of bamboo poles, receiver lines, casings (pipes), buoys, stakes, detectors, etc. The pipes are to be marked with flags by day and yellow lights by night. Generation of seismic energy source may be by drilling and detonation of shot points, discharge of air guns in water, and/or use of Vibraseis or other vibrating energy sources.

NOTICE the Louisiana Department of Natural Resources, Office of Coastal Management (OCM) is requesting to extend, for a period of 20 months, the permit term of the above Louisiana Coastal Use Permit issued April 15, 2011. The Office of Coastal Management (OCM) will accept public comments on this request for a period of ten (10) days from the date of publication in *The Advocate*. The sole reason for not allowing extension based upon public comment shall be that there has been a change in the conditions of the area affected by the permit since the permit was originally issued. Comments should be uploaded to our electronic record, but may be mailed, faxed or emailed to the designated OCM Reviewer. All comments must contain the appropriate application number and the commenter's full name and contact information.
