DESCRIPTION: Installation of one 3" flowline, approx. 2,151' in length, to serve the BN-1/BN-8 RA SUD; CBU No. 3 Well. Approx. 73 cu. yds. of native material will be displaced during jetting activities, approx. 22 cu. yds. of rock material will be required for bank stabilization, and approx. 1 cu. yd. of sand material will be required at pipeline crossing.

REVISION 1: Request to extend permit term.
