DESCRIPTION: Proposed installation of one (1) 4-inch flowline (+/-5,830'). Approximately 774 cubic yards of jetting required . Approximately 18 cubic yards of material will be displaced by jetting operations. Approximately 5 cubic yards sand bags will be used as fill at pipeline crossings. The existing wellhead protector structure will be refurbished or replaced. Approximately 0.13 acre of waterbottom may be impacted by the proposed activity.

REVISION 1: Term Extension
