LOCATION: **Plaquemines Parish, LA;** Lat. 29° 34' 53"N and Long. 89° 31' 00"W (NAD 83), X = 2,577,454 and Y = 337,149 (NAD 27); West Black Bay Field; approximately 17.4 miles from Pointe A La Hache, LA.

DESCRIPTION: Proposed installation of a typical drill barge and ten (10) temporary 3-pile clusters on location for drilling SL 195 QQ Well #118. In addition, four (4) temporary 3-pile clusters will be installed in the vicinity of the well for barge mooring. If successful, a typical well protector structure (+/-7' x 20') will be installed. No dredging or propwashing required for access. Approximately 0.32 acre of waterbottom may be impacted by the proposed activity.

REVISION 1: Surface location of West Black Bay SL 195 QQ Well #118 revised to move closer to the abandoned SL 195 QQ Well #22. New surface location is Lat. 29° 34' 54.4"N and Long. 89° 31' 11.9"W (NAD 83), X = 2,576,400 and Y = 337,260 (NAD 27). Proposing to install flowlines (2" GLL - +/-72' and 4" FL - +/-175') to tie-into existing SL 195 QQ Well #22 flowlines and removal of unused section of SL 195 QQ Well #22 2-inch flowline. Approximately 158 cubic yards of material will be displaced by jetting. Additionally, structure removal and site clearance operations for abandoned SL 195 QQ Well #22 included.

REVISION 2: Term Extension

NOTICE the Louisiana Department of Natural Resources, Office of Coastal Management (OCM) has received a request to extend the permit period for the above referenced Coastal Use Permit in accordance with the State and Local Coastal Resources Management Act of 1978, as amended, (Louisiana R.S. 49:214.21-214.41), and the rules and regulations of the Coastal Resources Program. The sole reason for not allowing extension based upon public comment shall be that there has been a change in the conditions of the area affected by the permit since the permit was originally issued.
