LOCATION: **Calcasieu Parish, LA;** Lat. 30° 06' 20.3"N and Long. 93° 17' 54.0"W; Section 16,17, 28, 28, 32, and 33; T11S-R9W; Henry Pugh Blvd; Lake Charles, LA.

DESCRIPTION: Proposal to dredge approximately 832,000 cubic yards of sediment and soil from a 16.2 acre area on the south shore of the Industrial Canal. The dredging area footprint will have an approximate average length of 1,900 feet width of 350 feet to provide sufficient berthing area for the LNG vessel. The basin will be dredged to 44ft NAVD88 (+2ft of advanced maintenance allowance) using a hydraulic cutterhead dredge directing spoil material via 2.5 miles of temporary pipeline along the Calcasieu River to a 307-acre BUDM site located north of Calcasieu Lake. Approximately 204,00 CY of upland soils would be excavated and relocated onsite, 73,000 CY from the berthing area and 131,200 CY to grade the remainder of the site. Approximately 5,000 cubic yards of concrete, 5,000 cubic yards of rock and 5,000 cubic yards of hauled in topsoil dirt required. Approximately 323 acres may be impacted by the proposed activity.

NOTICE the Louisiana Department of Natural Resources, Office of Coastal Management (OCM) has received the above application for a Coastal Use Permit (CUP) in accordance with the State and Local Coastal Resources Management Act of 1978, as amended, (Louisiana R.S. 49:214.21-214.41), and the rules and regulations of the Coastal Resources Program. Written comments, including suggestions for modifications or objections to the proposed work and stating the reasons thereof, are being solicited from the public. Comments must be received within 25 days of the date of publication of this notice. Comments should be uploaded to our electronic record, but may be mailed, faxed or emailed to the designated OCM Reviewer. All comments must contain the appropriate application number and the commenter's full name and contact information.

The public comment period for Coastal Use Permit applications begins on the date of publication of notice in the official journal (The Advocate), in accordance with LAC 43:I. 723(C)(5)(c). OCM will provide this date on request.

Any person may request, in writing, within the comment period specified in this notice, that a State or Federal

public hearing be held to consider this application. Requests for public hearings shall state, with particularity, the reasons for holding a public hearing and must contain the name and contact information of the requester.
