DESCRIPTION: Administrative Amendment to condition extension authorization for previously permitted project consisting of unauthorized additional fill not in compliance with previously permitted conditions. Rip rap fill previously permitted to 6' height, constructed to 13.8' elevation. Amended permit requires removal of fill to an elevation of 7.8'. 1842 cu. yds. of fill to be excavated and removed offsite. 1042 cu. yds. of additional fill to remain. Total of 7708 cu. yds. of fill. Unauthorized (protruding) rebar to be removed from concrete riprap. Construction of a private residence with a driveway, a 300' x 6' pier with a 40' x 24' boat dock. Approx. 6289 cu. yds. of sandy clay will be hauled in and used for proposed land reclamation. Approx. 71340 cu. yds. of rock material will be required for fill and approx. 33 cu. yds. of gravel will be required for driveway construction. Permit authorization will be extended for three years. Permit expiration date will be May 13, 2018.
