**DESCRIPTION:** Installation of one 4" flowline and one 2" flowline (each line approx. 3,823' in length) to serve the Rubber Ducky Prospect. Approx. 87 cu yds of native material will be temporarily displaced, 4.5 cu yds of rock material will be used for bank line stabilization and 1.78 cu yds of sand will be used at line crossings.

**REVISION 1:** A request of an extension of the permit term has been received.
