**DESCRIPTION:** Installation of one 4" flowline (3,475') and one 3" gas lift line (1,704') to serve SL 195 QQ Well No. 46. Approx. 762 cu. yds. of water bottom will be temporarily displaced as a result of jetting and 18 cu. yds. of sand will be used for pipeline crossings.
