DESCRIPTION: After-the-fact CUP application for the unauthorized excavation of a 50 ft x 139 ft x 17 ft slip for the repair of a leaking 10-inch pipeline serving the 11-6 Well location in Belle Isle Field. 1655.1 cy of spoil was excavated from slip with temporary deposition adjacent to slip. Spoil will be backfilled. Temporary spoil piles: 59ftx38ftx5ft and 49ft x 106ft x 120ft' x 52ft x 5ft will be backfilled. 0.16 acres of marsh habitat was temporarily impacted from the unauthorized dredging activities and 0.18 acres from the temporary spoil deposition. Proposed replacement of 10-inch pipeline (703 ft total length). POE 29-32-3.66/Long 90-23-28.91, POE LAT 29-32-8.07/Long 91-23-27.97. Proposed pipeline replacement from north side of unauthorized slip (158 ft), across Little Doctors Bayou (456 ft) and onto the south bank (89 ft). 20 ft x 20 ft x 6 ft temporary workspace at POB. Pipeline runs 3-4 ft below marsh elevation and 10 ft below canal bottom. Temporary trench for pipeline replacement to be backfilled. 15 ft airboat access ROW. 0.21 acres (1045 cy) of water bottoms to be temporarily impacted from proposed pipeline replacement. 0.033 acres (126.38 cy) of marsh habitat to be temporarily displaced due to proposed pipeline replacement. 0.03 acres (24.72 cy) temporarily impacted by airboat ROW. A one-year growing season will be conditioned to assess any primary or secondary impacts from the unauthorized and proposed activities. An Administrative Penalty will be issued for the unauthorized activities.
