DESCRIPTION: Proposed construction of the Greenfield Chemical Complex in Louisiana (the FG LA complex). The complex will include the construction of rail and docking facilities, power generation station, borrow pits and a central wastewater treatment plant. The project will require the use of 354,635 cu. yds. of sand material to be hauled in and placed on site to construct the foundation of the facility. In addition, approximately 249,197 cu. yds. of native material will be excavated to create the structures associated with the development and placed on site. Approx. 1,583 acres of upland habitat, approximately 20.00 acres of non-vegetated waterbottoms, and approximately 800.00 acres of vegetated wetlands may be impacted as a result of this proposed activity.

The Corps has conducted a preliminary analysis and has determined that the proposed project would directly impact approximately 61.7 acres of jurisdictional forested and herbaceous wetlands and approximately 56.4 acres of other waters of the U.S. It is anticipated that the proposed project would have minimal impact on adjacent wetlands
