**LOCATION:** **Plaquemines Parish, LA;** POB (2)4-inch flowlines / GIB SL214 #172 Twin -- Lat 29-03-57.81 N / Long. 89-09-44.65 W NAD83); x=2,693,592', y=151,729' (NAD27); POE (2)4-inch flowlines / South Flank Platform -- Lat 29-04-10.11 N / Long. 89-09-59.97 W; Approximately 17.5 miles southeasterly from Venice, LA.

**DESCRIPTION:** Proposed access dredge of a canal and slip to drill GIB SL214 #172 Twin; and install (2) 4-inch flowlines to South Flank Platform. A typical wellhead protection structure will be installed upon successful completion of the well. Approximately 11,890 cubic yards of native material will be temporarily displaced by access dredging activities and distributed on site. In addition, limestone will be used to stabilize the shorelines and 6 cubic yards of sand will be used at pipeline crossings. Approximately 5.50 acres of non-vegetated waterbottoms and 0.10 acres of vegetated wetlands may be impacted as a result of this proposed activity.

NOTICE the Louisiana Department of Natural Resources, Office of Coastal Management (OCM) has received the above application for a Coastal Use Permit (CUP) in accordance with the State and Local Coastal Resources Management Act of 1978, as amended, (Louisiana R.S. 49:214.21-214.41), and the rules and regulations of the Coastal Resources Program. Copies may be obtained upon payment of cost of copying. Written comments, including suggestions for modifications or objections to the proposed work and stating the reasons thereof, are being solicited from the public. Comments must be received within 25 days of the date of publication of this notice. Comments should be uploaded to our electronic record, but may be mailed, faxed or emailed to the designated OCM Reviewer. All comments must contain the appropriate application number and the commenter's full name and contact information.

The public comment period for Coastal Use Permit applications begins on the date of publication of notice in the official journal (The Advocate), in accordance with LAC 43:I. 723(C)(5)(c). OCM will provide this date on request.

Any person may request, in writing, within the comment period specified in this notice, that a State or Federal public hearing be held to consider this application. Requests for public hearings shall state, with particularity, the reasons for holding a public hearing and must contain the name and contact information of the requester.
