Exclusive Geophysical Agreements (EGA) are authorized under Title 30, Chapter 3, Sections 208 through 216 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950. An EGA may be obtained from the State Mineral and Energy Board (SMEB), through the Office of Mineral Resources (OMR). The three types of EGAs are EGA Type I, EGA Type II, and EGA Type III. Descriptions of the three types of EGA are detailed in LAC 43:V.103.

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NOMINATION INFORMATION

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	NOTICES TO BIDDER
PLEASE READ CAREFULLY	1. For an EGA Type I, the SMEB will not grant any new seismic agreements or permits in the nominated area during the Initial Term of the EGA or the Option Term, if activated.
DO NOT SUBMIT THIS PAGE WITH THE BID FORM	2. For an EGA Type II, the SMEB will not grant any new seismic agreements or permits, nor any new leases in the nominated area from the time it is nominated, during the Primary Term of the EGA or the Option Term, if activated. However, a buffer zone of 1/2 mile will be established around existing leases or operating agreements within the area of the EGA. Only the Grantee of the EGA and Lessee of any existing lease or operating agreement shall have the right, concurrent with, but separate from the right of the other, to nominate acreage for a state mineral lease within the buffer zone(s). Also, only the Grantee of the EGA shall have the right to nominate EGA acreage outside the buffer zone(s) for a state mineral lease during the Initial Term of the EGA or the Option Term, if activated.
	3. In addition to the rights stated in 2 above, only the Grantee of an EGA Type III shall have the exclusive right to select tracts within the EGA in order to enter into a lease agreement(s) with the State. The tracts selected by the Grantee shall not exceed 1500 acres each or one third (1/3) in the aggregate of the entire state acreage within the nominated EGA area, unless agreed to by the SMEB (LAC 43:V.103.E(3)). The lease agreement shall be issued in accordance with the State lease form.
The administrative and statutory fees required by law shall be paid to OMR by personal or business check at the time the Grantee selects acreage within the EGA for leasing.	4. For each selection resulting in a lease authorized by the SMEB, in addition to the required per acre Initial Payment and Royalty as advertised and bid during the acquisition of the EGA, an administrative fee of Ten (10%) Percent of the Bonus shall be paid (La. R.S. 30:124.F).
	5. For each selection resulting in a State mineral lease, the additional per acre fees required by La. R.S. 30:136.1.D for deposit into the Louisiana Wildlife and Fisheries Conservation Fund and into the Oil and Gas Regulatory Fund shall be collected from Grantees/Lessees.
	6. Sixteenth Section – Special procedures apply to nominations of tracts encompassing Sixteenth Section or Indemnity Lands over which the State of Louisiana possesses trustee title. If a nomination involves such a tract, the local School Board necessarily will be contacted and engaged to participate in the seismic agreement and mineral leasing processes.
See LAC 76:I.301	7. A party interested in obtaining an EGA should be aware that in accordance with La. R.S. 30:214, the Grantee of an EGA is required to comply with the rules and regulations relative geophysical exploration promulgated by the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries.
