## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, areas of north Louisiana have been designated as areas of ground water concern by the Commissioner of Conservation; and

WHEREAS, high-quality water is necessary for public health and economic development; and

WHEREAS, the United States of America, the State of Louisiana, the Sparta Commission, and several parish and local governments have initiated the desire to develop a concrete and sustainable ground water plan; and

WHEREAS, this initiative will require funding in order to move forward;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Louisiana Ground Water Resources Commission does hereby request the Department of Natural Resources through its staff to seek funding through the legislature, stimulus money or any other available source of funding to further its task of developing a Statewide Groundwater Management Plan.
