RE:

Electronic Reporting of Well Test and Inactive Well Report

The Office of Conservation is converting to a new paperless reporting system that will require all Louisiana Operators with oil and gas wells to electronically file their bi-annual DM-1-R and DT-1Well Tests and Inactive Well Reports beginning with the reports due on November 1, 2014.

The new on-line reporting system can be accessed at the following website: <a href="https://www.Sonris.com">www.Sonris.com</a>. A User's Guide explaining the process is available at the link.

Please note well test are due on November 1<sup>st</sup> and May 1<sup>st</sup> each year. All test dates shall be within 60 days prior to the due date of the report.

Any test filed after May 1<sup>st</sup> or November 1<sup>st</sup> shall be considered delinquent. Reports more than 30 days delinquent will result in a fine.
