LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m., on **WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 7, 2004**, upon the application of **BP AMERICA PRODUCTION COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the **21,300' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A and the 21,900' Tuscaloosa Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Judge Digby Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate for the 21,300' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A and one such unit for the 21,900' Tuscaloosa Zone, Reservoir A, said units to be designated 21300 TUSC RA SUE and 21900 TUSC RA SUC, respectively, all as shown on the plats submitted with the application.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within each of the proposed units, with each separate tract sharing in unit production on a surface acre basis of participation.
3. To designate BP America Production Company as operator for each of the proposed units.
4. To grant BP America Production Company permission to drill, designate and utilize its R N David No. 1 Well as unit well for each of the proposed units, at the location shown on the plats submitted with the application, said location being in accordance with the spacing provisions of the 1046-C and 1046-E Series of Orders and Statewide Order No. 29-E. In the event it becomes necessary to directionally control the proposed unit well, BP America Production Company plans to request authority to complete the well at a location no closer than 50 feet from the nearest unit line.
5. Except to the extent herein contrary, to extend to the proposed additional units all pertinent provisions of the 1046-C and 1046-E Series of Office of Conservation Orders, respectively, and all applicable Statewide Orders.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 21,300' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A, in the Judge Digby Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1046-C, effective March 19, 1997.

The 21,900' Tuscaloosa Zone, Reservoir A, in the Judge Digby Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1046-E, effective October 30, 2001.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
