

**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m., on **TUESDAY, MARCH 2, 2004**, upon the application of **STONE ENERGY CORPORATION**. At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the **37 Sand, Reservoir A**, in the Clovelly Field, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single reservoirwide unit comprised of the entirety of the 37 Sand, Reservoir A, as shown on the survey plat submitted with the application, and for the authorization and approval of a pressure maintenance and secondary recovery program, all in accordance with the provisions of Sub-section C of Section 5 of Title 30 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 (Act 441 of 1960), as amended.
2. To force pool and unitize all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed reservoirwide unit, with each tract sharing in unit production based on productive surface acres, all as set forth in the Unit Agreement which covers the plans and terms of operations and which participations are shown on the survey plat submitted with the application.
3. To approve and adopt the Unit Agreement for the 37 Sand, Reservoir A, which covers the plan and terms of unit operation for this reservoir.
4. To designate Stone Energy Corporation as operator of the proposed reservoirwide unit.
5. To authorize and approve for the proposed reservoirwide unit a pressure maintenance and secondary recovery program by the injection of water or other substances.
6. To provide for future reclassification of this reservoir without the necessity of a public hearing if reclassification becomes necessary due to a change in the producing characteristics.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 37 Sand, Reservoir A, in the Clovelly Field, Lafourche Parish, Louisiana, is defined as being that oil and gas bearing sand encountered between the depths of 11,015' and 11,047' (ELM) in the Stone Energy Corporation - Clovelly No. 40Well, located in Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 22 East. A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
