**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m., on **TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 10, 2004**, upon the application of **SAMSON KELLEY OPERATING COMPANY, LTD.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Hosston A Zone and the Hosston B Zone**, in the Sibley Field, Webster Parish, Louisiana.

1. To authorize applicant to drill, designate and utilize two (2) alternate unit wells for HOSS A SUJ, one (1) alternate unit well for HOSS B SUJ, two (2) alternate unit wells for HOSS A SUK and HOSS B SUK, and one (1) alternate unit well for HOSS A SUG and HOSS B SUG at the locations shown on the plats submitted with the application.
2. To approve exceptions to the well location provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 148-J, effective February 1, 1972, for any of the proposed wells the location of which, as shown on the plats submitted with the application, does not comply with the well location provisions in said Order.
3. To find that each of the proposed alternate unit wells is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the Hosston A and B Zones underlying the units on which it is proposed to be drilled which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any existing well on such units.
4. To approve the downhole combination of production from the Hosston A Zone and the Hosston B Zone in the wellbore of the proposed alternate unit well on HOSS A SUG and HOSS B SUG, and in the wellbore of any existing or future well located on these units in which the ownership interests in the Hosston A and B Zones is identical.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Hosston A and B Zones, in the Sibley Field, Webster Parish, Louisiana, were defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 148-J, effective February 1, 1972.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Shreveport**, Louisiana.
