Application is hereby made on behalf of Chevron, U.S.A. Inc., to the Commissioner of Conservation for the calling of a public hearing, after ten (10) days legal notice to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters concerning the "O" Sand, Segment 400, in the Mound Point Field, Iberia Parish, Louisiana.

1. To determine that the "O" Sand, Segment 400, has been economically depleted of hydrocarbons so that an exception to Statewide Order 29-B, Section XV 2.2 D may be granted.
2. To allow the applicant to utilize its S.L. 340 Number 59 well (SN 155886) to inject produced saltwater into the subject "O" Sand, Segment 400. Please refer to Injection and Mining Application # 23359.
3. To discuss any other matters that may be pertinent to this application.

The "O" Sand, Segment 400, is hereby defined as that saltwater bearing sand encountered between the depths of 9298' and 9320' in the Chevron, U.S.A. Inc., Mound Point #59 well, located in Iberia Parish, Louisiana.

Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, a list of names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Interested Parties and Represented Parties to whom this application is being sent is being furnished only to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation.
