LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m., on **TUESDAY, APRIL 6, 2004**, upon the application of **CASTEX ENERGY, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Pelican Zone, Reservoir C and FF Zone, Reservoir B**, in the Lapeyrouse Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

PELICAN ZONE, RESERVOIR C

1. To create a single drilling and production unit of approximately 108 acres for the Pelican Zone, Reservoir C, designated as the PEL RA SUA, all as shown more particularly on the plat submitted with the application.

The Pelican Zone, Reservoir C, in the Lapeyrouse Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the measured depths of 14,061' and 14,395' (ELM) in the Castex Energy, Inc. - A M Dupont No 2 Well, located in Section 17, Township 20 South, Range 18 East.

FF ZONE, RESERVOIR B

1. To create a single drilling and production unit of approximately 50 acres for the FF Zone, Reservoir B, designated as the FF RB SUA, all as shown more particularly on the plat submitted with the application.

The FF Zone, Reservoir B, in the Lapeyrouse Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the measured depths of 12,464' and 12,772' (ELM) in the Castex Energy, Inc. - A M Dupont No. 2 Well, in Section 17, Township 20 South, Range 18 East.

FOR THE ABOVE ZONE

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the said sand units.
2. To designate a unit operator and a unit well for the PEL RA SUA.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis participation.
4. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
