LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m., on **TUESDAY, APRIL 27, 2004**, upon the application of **GOODRICH PETROLEUM CORPORATION**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the **7475' Sand, Reservoir A**, in the Lake Charles Field, Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana.

1. To permit applicant, Goodrich Petroleum Corporation to drill, designate and utilize the Goodrich Petroleum Corporation - Bracey et al SL 3313 No. 1-Alt Well as an alternate unit well for the 7475' Sand, Reservoir A, such well to be at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To make a specific finding that such proposed alternate unit well is necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the 7475' Sand, Reservoir A which cannot be efficiently and economically drained by any other well within the unit.
3. To grant a single unit allowable for the 7475' Sand, Reservoir A and to permit the operator of the unit to produce said unit allowables from the unit well, the proposed alternate unit well, or from both wells, at its option.
4. To confirm Goodrich Petroleum Corporation as the operator of the 7475' Sand, Reservoir

5. To find that, except to the extent contrary in the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 613-G shall remain in full force and effect.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 7475' Sand, in the Lake Charles Field, Calcasieu, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 613-G, effective January 20, 2004.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
