

**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m., on **TUESDAY, JUNE 22, 2004**, upon the application of **PXP GULF COAST, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the **MA-1E Zone**, in the Garden City Field, St. Mary Parish, Louisiana.

1. To dissolve the existing drilling and production unit created for the MA-1E Sand, Reservoir A, by Office of Conservation Order No. 450-GG, effective October 29, 2002 and create a revised single drilling and production unit of approximately 245.01 acres for the MA-1E Zone, designated as the MA-1E RA SUA, all as shown more particularly on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the said unit.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the unit so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
4. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The MA-1E Sand in the Garden City Field was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 450-GG, effective October 29, 2002, and is further redefined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the measured depths of 17,117 feet and 17,530 feet (electrical log measurements) in the PXP (3 Tec)-Bailey Mineral Partnership No. 1 Well, location in Section 60, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, St. Mary Parish, Louisiana.
