LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JULY 13, 2004**, upon the application of **CHESAPEAKE OPERATING, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Austin Chalk Zone, Reservoir A**, in the West Cheneyville Field, Evangeline Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create four (4) additional drilling and production units for the exploration for and production of oil and gas, such units to be designated AUS C RA SUQ, AUS C RA SUR, AUS C RA SUS and AUS C RA SUT.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed units, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate Chesapeake Operating, Inc. as unit operator for each of the proposed units.
4. To designate a unit well for each of the proposed units.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Austin Chalk Zone, in the West Cheneyville Field, Evangeline Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined by Order No. 1415, effective March 11, 1997.
