

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JUNE 29, 2004**, upon the application of **KERR-McGEE OIL & GAS ONSHORE LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Hackberry 4 Sand, Reservoir A**, in the Topsy Field, Jefferson Davis Parish, Louisiana.

1. To permit the applicant to recomplete, designate and utilize its Hayes Lumber Company No. 1 Well as alternate unit well for the HBY 4 RA SUA, said well to be at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application, in compliance with the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 957-B, effective January 19, 1999, and Statewide Order No. 29-E.
2. To find that this well is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the reservoir covered by the unit which cannot be so drained by any existing well within such unit.
3. To permit the operator to produce the unit allowable from the existing unit well, the proposed alternate unit well or both, in any combination, at the discretion of the operator.
4. Except to the extent herein set forth, to continue in full force and effect the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 957-B and the unit created thereby relating to the Hackberry 4 Sand, Reservoir A.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Hackberry 4 Sand, Reservoir A, in the Topsy Field, Jefferson Davis Parish, Louisiana, was fully defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 957-B, effective January 19, 1999.
