

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, AUGUST 17, 2004**, upon the application of **GOODRICH PETROLEUM CORPORATION**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A**, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create seven (7) drilling and production units for the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, designated as the CV RA SU66, CV RA SU67, CV RA SU68, CV RA SU69, CV RA SU70, CV RA SU71, and CV RA SU72, all as shown more particularly on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the said units.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
4. To designate a unit operator and a unit well for the CV RA SU67 and CV RA SU68 proposed herein.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, in the Bethany-Longstreet Field, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Series of Orders 289-J, and is further defined in the CV RA SU65 as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the measured depths of 8,913 feet and 10,100 feet (electrical log measurements) in Goodrich Petroleum Corporation - Taylor No. 1 Well, located in Section 22, Township 14 North, Range 16 West, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana.
