**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m., on **TUESDAY, JANUARY 20, 2004**, upon the application of **DENBURY RESOURCES, INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the **3200' Sand, Reservoir A**, in the Bayou Sauveur Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create two drilling and production units, each for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the 3200' Sand, Reservoir A, such units to be designated 3200 RA SUA and 3200 RA SUB.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within each of the proposed units, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate a unit well for each of the proposed units.
4. To designate Denbury Resources, Inc. as the unit operator for each of the proposed units.
5. To provide that any future wells drilled to the 3200' Sand, Reservoir A, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorize to reclassify the 3200' Sand, Reservoir A, by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 3200' Sand, in the Bayou Sauveur Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the depths of 3,157' and 3,195' (ELM) in the Coastal States Gas Producing - Harry Bourg No. 1 Well, located in Section 2, Township 20 South, Range 16 East.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
