Aspect Energy, L.L.C., ("Applicant") hereby makes application to the Commissioner of Conservation for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating the Celotex Zone, Reservoir C, in the Bayou Segnette Field, Jefferson Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate.
2. To create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
4. To designate a unit operator and a unit well for the unit so created.
5. To provide that any future replacement or alternate unit wells drilled to the Celotex Zone, Reservoir C, should be exempt from the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Celotex Zone, Reservoir C, is hereby defined as that interval found between the depths of 9,845 feet and 10,550 feet, electrical log measurement,

in the Argo Oil Corporation - Canal Assets, Inc. No. 1 Well, located in Section 64, Township 14 South, Range 23 East, Jefferson Parish, Louisiana.


The pre-application conference was held as scheduled in the pre-application notice dated May 11, 2004, and a copy of the list of those who attended is attached. The conference was opened by Mr. John D. Moores and Mr. Louis Gilbert who explained the basis of the Applicants unit proposal. This was followed by a general question and answer period. Mr. E. Drury on behalf of himself expressed opposition to the proposed unit and stated that if his entire tract 8 land could not be included within the unit then he would like to have all of his acreage excluded from the unit. The conference was subsequently adjourned with no resolution of differences. The applicant will continue to attempt to resolve the noted opposition to their unit proposal.

The Applicant will provide for posting a copy of the Legal Notice of this hearing and a copy of the enclosed plat at a prominent place in the area affected by this application and will cause the publication of the Legal Notice in a newspaper published in the general area of the Bayou Segnette Field. Furthermore, a copy of the Legal Notice will be mailed to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties all in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure.

There is attached hereto and made a part hereof, a plat outlining the proposed unit and a list of names and addresses of the Interested Parties, Interested Owners and Represented Parties to whom this notice is being sent. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of Parties is being furnished ONLY to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation. The aforementioned list is available upon request to any Interested Party. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Parties, Interested Owners and Represented Parties as required by the Revised Rules of Procedure.

There is enclosed herewith a check made payable to the Office of Conservation, representing the required hearing application fee.
