

LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m., on **TUESDAY, JANUARY 27, 2004**, upon the application of **HUNT OIL COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Hackberry 4 Sand, Reservoir C**, in the Topsy Field, Jefferson Davis Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Hackberry 4 Sand, Reservoir C, said unit to be designated HBY 4 RC SUA.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate Hunt Oil Company as operator of the proposed unit.
4. To designate the Hunt Oil Company - Hayes Lumber Company Inc No. 1 Well as unit well for the proposed unit at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
5. To provide that any future wells drilled to the Hackberry 4 Sand, Reservoir C, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the Hackberry 4 Sand, Reservoir C, created herein by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Hackerry 4 Sand, Reservoir C, in the Topsy Field, Jefferson Davis Parish, Louisiana, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the depths of 7,620' and 7,738' (ELM), in the Hunt Oil Company - Hayes Lumber Company Inc No. 1 Well, located in Section 28, Township 7 South, Range 7 West.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
