LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 29, 2004**, upon the application of **THORNTON-PAGE NATURAL GAS**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Wilcox A Zone, Reservoir A**, in the North Searcy Field, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana.

1. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize one (1) additional unit well for the Wilcox A Zone, Reservoir A, in the unit designated WX RA SUJ at the location as shown on the attached plat, in exception to the spacing provisions of 1106-A Series of Office of Conservation Orders, such unit and well shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To find that an additional alternate unit well is needed to assist in the efficient and effective drainage of the Wilcox A Zone, Reservoir A, in the unit designated WX RA SUJ that cannot be drained by any other well located therein.
3. To permit the unit operator to produce the assigned unit allowable from the unit well, the alternate unit well or from a combination thereof at its discretion.
4. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Wilcox A Zone, Reservoir A, in the North Searcy Field, LaSalle Parish, Louisiana, was defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1106-A, effective June 7, 1989.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Monroe**, Louisiana.
