LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, OCTOBER 19, 2004**, upon the application of **CONOCOPHILLIPS COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Pettet Formation, Reservoir A**, all in the West Bryceland Field, Bienville Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Pettet Formation, Reservoir A, to be designated PET RA SUA, as shown outlined on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To force pool and integrate all of the separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests located within PET RA SUA in accordance with Section 10, Title 30, of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate ConocoPhillips Company as operator of the PET RA SUA and to designate the ConocoPhillips Company-Irvin 19 No. 1 Well as the unit well for PET RA SUA at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
4. To establish field rules for the Pettet Formation, Reservoir A, that require that wells be located no closer than 1000 feet to any unit line, and there be not less than 2000 feet between wells drilling to, producing from, or for which a permit has been issued to the Pettet Formation, Reservoir A.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Pettet Formation, Reservoir A, in the West Bryceland Field, Bienville Parish, Louisiana, is to be defined as that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 6643 feet and 7040 feet (electric log measurements) in the ConocoPhillips Company - Irvin 19 No. 1 Well, located in Section 19, Township 17 North, Range 6 West.
