LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m., on **WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 7, 2004**, upon the application of **CYPRESS OPERATING, INC.** At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of an Order pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Cotton Valley D Sand**, in the Greenwood-Waskom Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

1. To permit the applicant to drill, designate and utilize their Fournoy et al 27 No.1 Well as a substitute unit well for the CV D SUGG, in exception to the spacing provisions of the 193-B and 270-1 Series of Office of Conservation Orders, for the production of gas and condensate from the Cotton Valley D Sand, such unit and well shown on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To find that a substitute unit well at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application will assist in draining additional hydrocarbons beneath the unit designated CV D SUGG that cannot be drained by any existing well within the unit.
3. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Cotton Valley D Sand, in the Greenwood-Waskom Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana, was defined in 193-B and 270-1 Series of Office of Conservation Orders.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Shreveport**, Louisiana.
