GORDON FIELD  
BEAUREGARD PARISH, LA**

**Dear Commissioner Welch,**

Application is hereby made on behalf of KASH OIL & GAS to the Commissioner of Conservation for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the 6700 Zone, Reservoir A, in the Gordon Field, Beauregard Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations and to create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the 6700 Zone, Reservoir A, in the Gordon Field, Beauregard Parish, Louisiana, said unit to be designated 6700 RA SUA, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
3. To designate a unit operator and a unit well for the unit so created.
4. To provide that any wells drilled to the 6700 Zone, Reservoir A shall be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
5. To provide that the Commissioner may reclassify the reservoirs by Supplemental Orders without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished by the Commissioner.

6. To discuss any other matters that may be pertinent to this application.

The 6700 Zone, in the Gordon Field, is hereby defined as that gas and condensate bearing sands encountered between the depths of 6683'—6775' electric log measured in Union Oil Co., Edgewood Land & Lumber Co. No. 9 well, located in Section 26, Township 6 South, Range 10 West, Beauregard Parish, Louisiana.

In compliance with the Rules of Procedure, a pre-application notice was given, but no request for a conference was received, and therefore, none was held.

All pertinent data relating to the subject application can be obtained **AT THE COST OF THE REQUESTING PARTY**, from David Sturlese, P. O. Box 51405, Lafayette, LA 70505, (337) 232-1700.

There are attached hereto and made a part hereof, plats outlining the proposed unit. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, a list of the names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Interested Parties and Represented Parties to whom this application is being sent is being furnished **ONLY** to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation. However, the list of parties will be provided to any party requesting a copy. A diligent effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Interested Parties and Represented Parties as required by the Revised Rules of Procedure. Also enclosed is our check made payable to the Office of Conservation, representing the required hearing application fee.
