LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2004**, upon the application of **CABOT OIL & GAS CORP.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Lower Hosston Transitional Zone, Reservoir A**, and the **Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A**, in the Clear Branch Field, Jackson Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create five (5) drilling and production units for the Lower Hosston Transitional Zone, Reservoir A, as shown more particularly on the plat submitted with the application.
2. To amend the spacing provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 939-B, effective August 9, 1978 to allow any future wells drilled to the Lower Hosston Transitional Zone, Reservoir A, to be located no closer than 330 feet from any unit line and no closer than 1,500 feet between wells.
3. To create seven (7) drilling and production units for the Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, as shown more particularly on the plat submitted with the application.
4. To provide that any wells drilled to the Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, to be located no closer than 330 feet from any unit line and no closer than 1,500 feet between wells.
5. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from said units.
6. Force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
7. To find that, except to the extent contrary herewith, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order Nos. 989-B and 989-B-1, shall remain in full force and effect.
8. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Lower Hosston Transitional Zone, Reservoir A was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 989-B, effective August 9, 1978.

The Cotton Valley Zone, Reservoir A, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the measured depths of 11,175 feet and 14,920 feet in the Anadarko Petroleum - Davis Brothers No. 1 Well located in Section 16, Township 16 North, Range 2 West.
