Dear Sir:

Application is hereby made on behalf of Marlin Coastal, LLC, to the Commissioner of Conservation for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Bolivina Perca Zone, Reservoir Q and Reservoir R, in the South Thornwell Field, Jefferson Davis Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Bolivina Perca Zone, Reservoir Q and Reservoir R, in the South Thornwell Field, Jefferson Davis Parish, Louisiana.

2. To create two drilling and production units, being designated BOL P RQ SUA and BOL P RR SUA and to force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created.

3. To designate a unit operator and a unit well for the units so created.

4. To provide that any well drilled outside of the Bolivina Perca Zone, Reservoir Q and Reservoir R, shall be in accordance with the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.

5. To provide that the Commissioner may reclassify the Reservoirs by supplemental order and without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted, based on evidence furnished the Commissioner.

6. To discuss any other matters that may be pertinent to this application.

The Bolivina Perca Zone in the South Thornwell Field, Jefferson Davis Parish, Louisiana was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 479-C-34, effective March 11, 2003.

In addition to furnishing the legal notice to all Interested Parties, the applicant will provide for POSTING of the legal notice of the hearing and unit plat in a prominent place in the area of the South Thornwell Field, Jefferson Davis Parish, Louisiana, and will cause the legal notice of the hearing to be PUBLISHED in a newspaper of general circulation published in the vicinity of the South Thornwell Field, Jefferson Davis Parish, Louisiana, at least fifteen (15) days before the hearing date.

Any pertinent data relating to the subject application can be obtained, **AT THE COST OF THE REQUESTING PARTY**, from David Comeaux at Leon E. Comeaux & Associates, 305 La Rue France, Lafayette, Louisiana 70508 (337-233-9839).

In compliance with the Rules of Procedure, a preapplication conference was held in Lafayette, Louisiana, on July 18, 2005, at which the parties named on the attached list were in attendance.

The conference was opened with a discussion by Mr. David Comeaux, representing Marlin Coastal, LLC concerning the nature and purpose of the conference and the bases for the applicant's proposed units.

Mr. Bill Clay, representing the Pucheu/Rhodes Interest, presented a counter-plan for Reservoir Q only. His plan differed from the applicant in the placement of the western boundary of the unit. Questions were asked and answered. No resolution was reached but the parties agreed to continue discussions in that regard.


Since the conference, the parties have agreed to a compromise outline for Reservoir Q only as depicted on the attached plat. No opposition is expected at the hearing in this matter.

There are attached hereto and made a part hereof a revised plat outlining the proposed units, the conference attendance list, and a list of the names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Represented Parties, and Interested Parties to whom this application is being sent. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of parties is being furnished **ONLY** to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation. However, said list of parties will be provided to any party requesting a copy. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.

Finally, there is enclosed our check on behalf of the applicant, Marlin Coastal, LLC, in the sum of \$755.00 payable to the Office of Conservation and representing the required hearing application fee.




