LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2005**, upon the application of **BRIGHTON ENERGY, LLC**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **L Sand, Reservoir A**, in the Roanoke Field, Jefferson Davis Parish, Louisiana.

1. To redefine the L Sand, Reservoir A, as being that oil, gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the depths of 7,613 feet and 8,028 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Brighton Energy, LLC - Taylor Heirs No. 2, located in Section 12, Township 9 South, Range 4 West, Jefferson Davis Parish, Louisiana.
2. To permit the unit operator to designate and utilize their Taylor Heirs No. 2 Well as a substitute unit well for the L RA SUA, at the location shown on the plat submitted with the application.
3. To find that the proposed substitute unit well is necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the unit which cannot be drained by any existing wells.
4. Except for the requests set forth above, to confirm and continue in effect the L RA SUA, established by Office of Conservation Order No. 124-T, effective August 26, 1997.
5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The L Sand, Reservoir A, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 124-T, effective August 26, 1997, and is hereby redefined as set forth hereinabove.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
