Application is hereby made on behalf of **El Paso Production Co.** for the calling of a public hearing, after ten days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters regarding the Sub Alliance Sand, Reservoir A, Cameron Canal Field, Cameron and Vermilion Parishes, Louisiana, for which rules and regulations were established and a drilling and production unit was created by the Office of Conservation Order No. 1076 and 1076-A series, effective October 31, 1979 and the 13000' Sand, Reservoir A, Cameron Canal Field, Cameron and Vermilion Parishes, Louisiana, for which rules and regulations were established and a drilling and production unit was created by the Office of Conservation Order No. 1076-B, effective July 16, 1980.

**Sub Alliance Sand, Reservoir A**

1. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E and Office of Conservation Order No. 1076 and 1076-A series, El Paso Production Co. to designate and utilize the El Paso Production Co.-Blanche Fremaux No. 1 Well as a substitute unit well for the Sub Alliance Sand, Reservoir A, such well to be at the approximate location shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof;
2. The Sub Alliance Sand, Reservoir A, Cameron Canal Field, Cameron and Vermilion Parishes, Louisiana was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1076 and 1076-A series, effective October 31, 1979.

**13000' Sand, Reservoir A**

1. To grant an exception to the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E and Office of Conservation Order No. 1076-B, El Paso Production Co. to designate and utilize the El Paso Production Co.-Blanche Fremaux No. 1 Well as a substitute unit well for the 13000' Sand, Reservoir A, such well to be at the approximate location shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof;

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2. The 13000' Sand, Reservoir A, Cameron Canal Field, Cameron and Vermilion Parishes, Louisiana was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1076-B, effective July 16, 1980.

For the above Sands

1. These wells are necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the reservoir covered by the units which cannot be effectively and efficiently drained by any existing well within such units;
2. To confirm El Paso Production Co. as the operator of the units.
3. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Office of Conservation Nos. 1076, 1076-A series and 1076-B shall remain in full force and effect, and
4. To consider such other matters which may be pertinent to this application as shown by the evidence presented at the hearing held on this matter.




Finally, there is enclosed our check on behalf of the applicant in the amount of \$1,510.00, made payable to the Office of Conservation, which represents the required hearing application fee.


