Renaissance Petroleum Co., LLC, hereby makes application to the Commissioner of Conservation for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating the 10,400' Zone, Reservoir C, in the Lapeyrouse Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate.
2. To create a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
4. To designate a unit operator and a unit well at a location which is an exception to the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E for the unit so created.
5. To provide that any future replacement or alternate unit wells drilled to the 10,400' Zone, Reservoir C, should be exempt from the spacing provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 10,400' Zone, Reservoir C, in the Lapeyrouse Field, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing sand encountered between the depths of 9,994' and 10,623' (MD) less and except the 10,500' Sand, encountered from the depths of 10,482' to 10,493' (electrical log measurements) in the Renaissance Petroleum Co LLC - Lirette No. 1 Well (WSN 229476), located in Section 31, Township 19 South, Range 18 East, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

A timely request for the Pre-Hearing Conference as tentatively scheduled in the Pre-Application Notice dated October 12, 2005 was received and subsequently held on November 2, 2005. No party other than the undersigned was in attendance including all known Interested Owners, Represented Parties, and Interested Parties to whom a copy of the Pre-Application Notice was mailed. Since no parties were in attendance at the conference, no opposition is anticipated to the applicants' proposal.

All pertinent data relating to the subject application is available for inspection at the Offices of Louis Gilbert & Associates, Inc., 1101 South Hugh Wallis Road, Ste. 201, Lafayette, Louisiana. Any person wishing to inspect such data should contact the undersigned at (337) 233-3097 during normal business hours in order to arrange a date and time for such inspection. A copy of any such pertinent data that is not otherwise available from the Office of Conservation can be obtained at the expense of the requesting party.

The Applicant will provide for posting a copy of the Legal Notice of this hearing and a copy of the proposed unit plat at a prominent place in the area affected by this application and will cause the publication of the Legal Notice in a newspaper published in the general area of the Lapeyrouse Field. Furthermore, a copy of the Legal Notice will be mailed to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties all in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof, a plat outlining the proposed unit and a list of names and addresses of the Interested Parties, Interested Owners and Represented Parties to whom this notice is being sent. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of Parties is being furnished ONLY to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation. The aforementioned list is available upon request to any Interested Party. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Parties, Interested Owners and Represented Parties as required by the Revised Rules of Procedure.

Finally, enclosed is our check on behalf of the applicant, made payable to the Office of Conservation and representing the required hearing application fee.


