APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC HEARING

Dear Sir:

Petro-Hunt, L.L.C. hereby makes application pursuant to the revised rules of procedure for a public hearing to consider evidence relating to the following matters pertaining to the the Cotton Valley Formation, Reservoir A, in the Holly Field, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana:

1. To authorize Petro-Hunt, L.L.C. to drill, designate and utilize an alternate unit well for CV RA SUFF at the location in Section 4, Township 14 North, Range 14 West, DeSoto Parish, Louisiana, shown on the attached plat, in the exception to the spacing provisions of applicable orders;
2. To establish that the proposed alternate unit well is necessary to recover hydrocarbons from CV RA SUFF that cannot be produced from any other well located on this unit;
3. To authorize the unit allowable for CV RA SUFF to be recovered from the existing well located on the unit, the proposed alternate unit well, or any combination thereof, at the discretion of the operator; and
4. To consider and cover such other matters as the Commissioner of Conservation may deem appropriate and necessary under the circumstances.




