Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **BP AMERICA PRODUCTION COMPANY** for the calling of a public hearing, after ten (10) days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the above referenced units, all in Judge Digby Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana, for which rules and regulations were established and drilling and production units were created for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate by Office of Conservation Order No. 1046, effective September 6, 1978, as amended by the 1046-A Series of Orders, the 1046-F, the 1046-D and the 1046-C Series of Office of Conservation Orders, respectively, including the units designated U TUSC RA SUA, U TUSC RA SUC, U TUSC RA SUD, 20350 TUSC RA SUA, 20350 TUSC RA SUD, L TUSC RA SUC, 20800 TUSC RA SUA, 21100 TUSC RA SUA, 21100 TUSC RA SUD, and 21300 TUSC RA SUA:

1. To permit the applicant to recomplete, designate and utilize the following wells as alternate unit wells: its W. C. Parlange No. 10 and No. 12 Wells for U TUSC RA SUA; its Wurtele No. 1 Well for U TUSC RA SUC and its Ivy Major No. 4 Well for U TUSC RA SUD, all located as shown on the plat attached hereto. The Wurtele No. 1 Well is located in exception

to the spacing provisions of the 1046-A Series of Orders and LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E). The other wells are legally located in their respective units.

2. To permit the applicant to recomplete, designate and utilize the following wells as alternate unit wells: its W. C. Parlange No. 10 and No. 12 Wells for 20350 TUSC RA SUA and its Ivy Major No. 4 Well for 20350 TUSC RA SUD, all located as shown on the plat attached hereto, in accordance with the spacing provisions of the 1046-A Series of Orders and LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).

3. To permit the applicant to recomplete, designate and utilize its Wurtele No. 1 Well as an alternate unit well for L TUSC RA SUC, located as shown on the plat attached hereto, in exception to the spacing provisions of the 1046-A Series of Orders and LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).

4. To permit the applicant to recomplete, designate and utilize its Parlange No. 12 Well as an alternate unit well for 20800 TUSC RA SUA, located as shown on the plat attached hereto, in accordance with the spacing provisions of the 1046-F Series of Orders and LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).

5. To permit the applicant to recomplete, designate and utilize the following wells as alternate unit wells: its W. C. Parlange No. 12 Well for 21100 TUSC RA SUA and its Ivy Major No. 4 Well for 21100 TUSC RA SUD, all located as shown on the plat attached hereto, in accordance with the spacing provisions of the 1046-D Series of Orders and LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).

6. To permit the applicant to recomplete, designate and utilize the following wells as alternate unit wells: its W. C. Parlange No. 12 Well and Ivy Major No. 4 Well for 21300 TUSC RA SUA, all located as shown on the plat attached hereto, in accordance with the spacing provisions of the 1046-C Series of Orders and LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E).

7. To permit the operator to produce the unit allowable for each of the above mentioned units from the existing unit well and the existing and proposed alternate unit wells, in any combination, at its option.

8. To find that the aforementioned wells are necessary to efficiently and economically drain a portion of the reservoir covered by each of the subject units which cannot be so drained by any existing well within said units.

9. Except to the extent herein designated, to continue in full force and effect the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 1046, as amended and supplemented by the 1046-A Series of Orders, and the 1046-F, the 1046-D and the 1046-C Series of Office of Conservation Orders and the units created thereby.

10. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Upper Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A, in the Judge Digby Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in 1046-A Series of Office of Conservation Orders, and redefined by Office of Conservation Order No. 1046-A-14, effective January 12, 2000.

The 20,350' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A, in the Judge Digby Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1046-A-15, effective January 12, 2000, and was redefined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1046-A-38, effective April 6, 2004.

The Lower Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A, in the Judge Digby Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1046, effective September 6, 1978, and redefined by Office of Conservation Order No. 1046-A-31, effective July 23, 2002.

The 20,800' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A, in the Judge Digby Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1046-F, effective July 23, 2002.

The 21,100' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A, in the Judge Digby Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1046-D, effective June 2, 1998.

The 21,300' Tuscaloosa Sand, Reservoir A, in the Judge Digby Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 1046-C, effective March 19, 1997.

In the opinion of the applicant, the recompletion, designation and use of the aforementioned wells are necessary to efficiently and economically drain the subject units that they will serve and such designation and use will not cause harm or injury to others. The proposed designation and use of each well should increase efficient recovery of the contents of the subject reservoirs and promote orderly development of the field.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof are plats outlining the applicant's proposals along with a list of the names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties to whom a copy of this application is being sent. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, such list of parties is being furnished only to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation; however, the list of parties will be provided to any party requesting a copy of it. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Interested Parties and Represented Parties.
