Dear Mr. Commissioner:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **Mission Resources Corporation** for the calling of a public hearing, after ten days legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters regarding the G9 RS Sand, Reservoir B, SUA, West Lake Verret Field, St. Martin Parish, Louisiana, for which rules and regulations were established and a drilling and production unit was created by the Office of Conservation Order No. 50-EEE-1, effective September 14, 2004.

1. To permit applicant, Mission Resources Corporation to drill, designate and utilize Mission Resources Corporation-JL&S No. 150 Well as a substitute unit well for the G9 RS RB SUA, such well to be at the location shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof;
2. This well is necessary to effectively and efficiently drain a portion of the reservoir covered by the unit which cannot be effectively and efficiently drained by any existing well within such unit;
3. To confirm Mission Resources Corporation as the operator of the G9 RS RB SUA;
4. To find that, except to the extent contrary to the order granted by the Commissioner of Conservation in connection with the hearing held on this application, the provisions of Office of Conservation No. 50-EEE-1, shall remain in full force and effect, and

5. To consider such other matters which may be pertinent to this application as shown by the evidence presented at the hearing held on this matter.

The G9 RS Sand, Reservoir B, West Lake Verret Field, St. Martin Parish, Louisiana was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 50-EEE-1, effective September 14, 2004.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a plat outlining the G9 RS RB SUA, showing the location of the substitute unit well together with a list of the names and addresses of all interested owners, interested parties and represented parties who are known to the applicant after reasonable search. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all such parties.

A copy of the list of the names and addresses of the interested owners, interested parties and represented parties is not being mailed to those parties along with this hearing application. Should any of these parties desire a copy of this list, however, we will be glad to provide one upon request.




