LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JULY 19, 2005**, upon the application of **THE MERIDIAN RESOURCE & EXPLORATION L.L.C.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Cibicides Opima Zone, Reservoir A and the Robulus L Sand, Reservoir B**, in the North Turtle Bayou Field, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

1. To create single drilling and production units for the Cibicides Opima Zone, Reservoir A and Robulus L Zone, Reservoir B.
2. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the said units.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the units so created, with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
4. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Cibicides Opima Zone, Reservoir A, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the measured depths of 13,520 feet and 14,740 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Standard Oil Production Company - Continental Land & Fur Co Inc B No. 1 Well, located in Section 23, Township 17 South, Range 13 East, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

The Robulus L Zone, Reservoir B, is hereby defined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the measured depths of 14,380 feet and 15,365 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Sohio Petroleum Company - Continental Land & Fur Co Inc No. 1 Well, located in Section 13, Township 17 South, Range 13 East, Terrebonne Parish, Louisiana.

Plats are available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge and Lafayette**, Louisiana.
