LEGAL NOTICE

STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, JULY 19, 2005**, upon the application of **WAGNER OIL COMPANY**.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **14700' Zone, Reservoir C**, in the South Mermentau Field, Acadia, Louisiana.

1. To redefine the 14700' Zone, Reservoir C, previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 385-A-5, effective January 5, 1993.
2. Except as may be in conflict with the provisions hereof, the provisions of Office of Conservation Order No. 385-A-5, effective January 5, 1993, shall remain in full force and effect.
3. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The 14700' Zone, Reservoir C, was previously defined in Office of Conservation Order No. 385-A-5, effective January 5, 1993, and is hereby redefined as being that gas and condensate bearing zone encountered between the measured depths of 14,804 feet and 15,176 feet (electrical log measurements) in the Wagner Oil Company - Spurgeon No. 1 Alt Well, located in Section 65, Township 10 South, Range 2 West, Acadia Parish, Louisiana.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in **Baton Rouge** and **Lafayette**, Louisiana.
